Parking, Shuttle Recently Asked Questions

I work second shift at Harper. How do I get from Harper to my parked car at Hutzel deck after 8 p.m.?

Answer: The DMC Shuttle Service now runs until 9p.m. DMC has a Transportation Escort Service for DMC approved employees, in need of a ride back to their parking area between the hours of 9p.m.-5a.m., outside of normal shift change. Please contact 313-745-1661, 15 minutes prior to departure time. A DMC Security vehicle will meet you at your front hospital entrance.

I'm a DMC employee at Sinai-Grace Hospital. Is there a designated area to park if I come to Central Campus meetings other than paying for parking at the respective locations?

Answer: Off-site DMC employees can receive temporary access to a Central Campus lot for one day by calling the Parking & Transportation Service Center at 313-745-2415 ahead of time.

In an effort to provide service for as many DMC employees as possible, the DMC Parking Committee's new *Continuous Central Campus Loop* shuttle has expanded its
